It has just 66,000 original miles and spent its life in California with a full record of what has been spent on the wagon over the years. Our plans are ship the wagon to New Zealand thanks to Marcus & Paul at Famous Autos, lower it and again we'll be fitting Cragar wheels, new tyres, Kicker sound system and a nice shiny paint job thanks to House of Kolor.
